What is ESCOCOM CONNECTS?

ESCOCOM CONNECTS, an intergenerational program of Emeritus Students College of Marin, offers support to COM students as they explore career avenues, prepare to transfer to 4-year schools, and move forward in their lives. ESCOCOM members have rich and diverse backgrounds and knowledge in a broad scope of industries and life experiences. ESCOCOM CONNECTS is ready and willing to bring a wealth of life and professional experiences, expertise, and wisdom to support the College's faculty, staff, and students.

ESCOCOM members offer a perspective based on years of hands-on experience in careers including banking, marketing, architecture, technology, law, public relations, sales, manufacturing, entrepreneurship, teaching, research, medicine, science and the arts. This is an interactive opportunity for students to establish a mutually beneficial relationship with an active senior eager to connect with the energy and enthusiasm of COM students. This partnership provides ESCOCOM members occasions to learn about the students' career and educational goals, passions and challenges.

Why ESCOCOM CONNECTS?

- Students exposed to 3 or more industries are 90% more likely to get an interview.
- 70% of jobs are gained through networking—First generation students often lack access to these networks.

COM faculty and staff are faced with the challenge of capturing the intellect and interest of their students. ESCOCOM CONNECTS is structured to offer such assistance. With a membership list of over 2000, ESCOCOM coordinators will identify and select appropriate members to fit the faculty request. Be it a discussion panel addressing leadership, assistance with an election day event, entrepreneurial guidance, interviewing techniques, scientific career opportunities, or preparation of an art display, ESCOCOM's members are ready to serve.

How Do I Start?

The process is quite simple. Once a faculty or staff member decides to utilize the program, they contact the ESCOCOM CONNECTS coordinator to discuss the proposed project and the process begins. The details of subject matter, time, place, goals, and review are discussed. The coordinator then reaches out to the appropriate ESCOCOM CONNECTS members to make the arrangements. The volunteers are linked directly with faculty or staff to finalize expectations and logistics. Afterwards ESCOCOM CONNECTS will conduct a follow up evaluation.



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Their intent is to connect with students, faculty, and classified professionals and share their expertise as guest speakers, panelists and mentors. It's a win-win-win that breathes new life into the organization and honors the diverse backgrounds and knowledge of our ESCOM members.
